APPROVE AGENDA	Jergens moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried
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unanimously.

PUBLIC FORUM Kelsey Wigans would like to apply for a \$25,00.00 grant to build a honey house

north of the school. This would pay for most of it but wants board approval as some of the cost will come from the school. Habben moved to approve this if the grant is awarded, seconded by Jergens. Motion carried unanimously.

BUDGET HEARING FOR 2019-2020 BUDGET

The board held a budget hearing from 5:46-5:50 P.M. with no objectors. At 5:50 Habben moved to approve the 2019-2020 budget, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried unanimously.

ADOPTION OF 2019-2020 BUDGET

Jergens moved to approve the presented budget with a 9.31883 tax rate, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVE BOARD RESOLUTION FOR BUDGET Habben moved to approve participation if needed, seconded by Jergens. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVE 2019-2020 AEA PURCHASING AGREEMENT Habben moved to approve the the AEA purchase agreement for 2109-2020, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVE LINDQUIST SCHOLARSHIP Habben move to approve a \$100.00 scholarship to our only district student graduating this year, seconded by Dickey. Jergens abstained. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVE PPEL/SAVE PROJECTS FOR SUMMER 2019 There are 10 maintenance projects on the list for this summer. We need to purchase a bus and fix the roof of our building which will use most of the budget. The other items are tiling, tree trimming and other items. Jergens moved to approve these items, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried unanimously.

# ADMINISTRATIVE REMARKS

Superintendent Herzberg shared with the Board that he has 4 applicants he is in the process of interviewing for the Special Education position. He has interviewed an Art teacher and is waiting to hear back on their decision. Habben moved to approve an increase to Kelsey Wigans pay for 2019-2020 at 6 percent, seconded by Dickey. Motion carried unanimously.

Principal Fenske gave an update on ISASP testing. The students are testing now and testing is going very well as this is the first year that it is done online.

Jergens moved, seconded by Habben to approve the following contracts for the 2019-2020 school year.
